


Woden ISD High School Survey Results



School Safety and Discipline

Successes:

Fifty two percent of the respondents responding to this survey were females attending Woden ISD and the other forty eight percent were males. Most of the students responded that they feel safe and secure, including in the hallways and bathrooms attending Woden ISD. Students agreed that teachers and administrators do a good job of supervising after-school activities. School staff members consistently enforce school rules.

Strategic Needs:

Many students do not feel safe and secure knowing that cameras are located throughout the campus and interior/exterior doors are secured during school hours. Many students agreed that student bullying and threatening one another is a problem. Students teasing and picking on each other is common. Many students do not behave in an orderly manner. Some students have seen other students carrying weapons. Several students agreed they are often a victim of violence in their school. Some students have been sexually harassed while at school. The Code of Student Conduct is not always consistent and fairly enforced.

School Environment:

Successes:

Most students feel that their school is kept clean. School grounds are kept neat and free of trash.

Strategic Needs:

Many students agreed they use drugs. Some students have been approached by other students to use drugs.

School Relationships and Participation:

Successes:

Students feel that they have a good relationship with their teachers and their teachers show them respect. Students are involved in different school activities.

Strategic Needs:

Many students do not like attending Woden ISD. Most students do not feel comfortable talking with teachers about their problems. Some students have been mean to others because of race or ethnicity. Students feel they are not involved in making decisions.

Academic Environment

Successes:

Most students agreed that there are high standards for academic performance.
